OFFICIAL REGULATION

I. PURPOSE OF THE SYMPOSIUM

The International Symposium “**NEW HORIZONS IN EDUCATION**” aims to promote and valorize new directions in the development of contemporary education by encouraging pedagogical innovation, the responsible integration of emerging technologies, the development of future-oriented competencies, and the facilitation of international exchange of experiences, research, and best practices, with a view to building relevant, inclusive, and adaptable educational models capable of responding to the transformations of present and future society.

II. OBJECTIVES OF THE SYMPOSIUM

1. **To promote innovative and future-oriented educational perspectives** through the international exchange of best practices, professional experiences, and relevant research contributing to the advancement of contemporary education.
2. **To develop teachers’ professional competencies** through the valorization of pedagogical innovation, digital technologies, interdisciplinary approaches, and modern teaching-learning-assessment strategies.
3. **To promote and disseminate scientific and educational contributions** through the presentation and publication of participants’ papers in the Symposium Proceedings, with ISSN, thereby enhancing visibility and knowledge exchange within the international educational community.
4. **To develop and strengthen sustainable educational partnerships** among institutions, teaching staff, and education professionals from different countries, in order to foster international collaboration, intercultural dialogue, and the exchange of best practices.
5. **To encourage an educational culture open to change and progress**, based on creativity, inclusion, adaptability, and lifelong learning, capable of opening new horizons for education and responding to the challenges of contemporary and future society.

III. THEME

The International Symposium “**NEW HORIZONS IN EDUCATION**” promotes the exploration and valorization of new directions in contemporary education, focusing on pedagogical innovation, the responsible integration of artificial intelligence and emerging technologies, the development of future-oriented competencies, personalized learning, and the adaptation of teaching strategies to the needs of a constantly changing society, while also supporting international collaboration and the exchange of best practices for the development of relevant, inclusive, and progress-oriented educational experiences.

IV. ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

- **Teaching staff** from pre-university and university education (early childhood educators, primary teachers, secondary teachers, lecturers, assistant professors, university professors).
- **Educational and administrative personnel** (educational counsellors, school inspectors, school principals, academic managers) involved in the development, implementation, and evaluation of educational strategies at national and international level.



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V. STRUCTURE OF THE SYMPOSIUM

The symposium is structured into a single section dedicated to the dissemination of academic research and educational reflection in an international context:

Scientific Papers and Educational Essays — Articles and essays analyzing educational models, public policies, teaching strategies, and interdisciplinary research, with a focus on pedagogical innovation, digitalization, international collaboration, and the adaptation of education to the challenges of the 21st century.

- Teaching projects, supplementary materials, worksheets, questionnaires, presentations, and other educational tools will not be accepted.
- Papers must be submitted exclusively in **.doc/.docx** (Microsoft Word) or **.pdf** format. Other formats (e.g., .ppt/.pptx, images, etc.) will not be accepted.
- Paper length: **5 pages maximum**.

VI. REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMITTED PAPERS

Papers submitted for publication must fall within one of the established sections of the Symposium.

Formatting Requirements:

- **Font:** Times New Roman, 12 pt
- **Spacing:** 1.5 lines
- **Length:** maximum 5 pages
- Papers must be submitted exclusively in **.doc/.docx** (Microsoft Word) or **.pdf** format. Other formats (e.g., .ppt/.pptx, images, etc.) will not be accepted

Mandatory Structure of the Paper:

- **Title of the paper** – written entirely in uppercase letters and centered.
- **Author's/Authors' name(s) and institutional affiliation** – placed immediately below the title, right-aligned.
- **Complete bibliography**, drafted according to academic standards (author, title, publisher, city, year).

Important Notes:

- The responsibility for the content and originality of the papers lies exclusively with the authors.
- Papers with a maximum of **two authors** are accepted; in this case, each participant must pay the registration fee and will receive all documents included in the “Teacher’s Package.”
- Papers must be submitted **online**, through the participant’s account on the website www.edumanagement.institute.



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VII. PACKAGES OFFERED TO PARTICIPANTS

To meet both the professional needs of participating teachers and the official requirements established by current legislation regarding continuous professional development, merit-based career advancement, and teacher mobility (Law No. 198/2023, Law No. 199/2023, Order No. 3251/2023 regarding merit grading, Order No. 3803/2023 regarding continuous training, and Regulation No. 15/2019 of Bulgaria), each participant will receive a personalized package of documents.

These documents are issued in **trilingual format** (Romanian, English, Bulgarian) and are recognized as supporting evidence for the professional portfolio.

1. Participant Package (Basic)

This package is designed for all participating teaching staff. It includes the essential documents required for the professional portfolio and for annual performance evaluation:

- **International Scientific Certificate of Participation** in the International Symposium “*NEW HORIZONS IN EDUCATION*” issued in three languages;

Important Notes

All documents are issued in **trilingual format (EN/RO/BG)** and comply with current legal provisions.

- Documents are delivered both online and in printed format, via Post.

- **Symposium Journal (digital format, with ISSN):** available online from 13 November 2026.
